



NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF NAME OR ADDRESS LICENSING ACT 2003: Section 127 (Personal Licence)

Personal Licence holders have a legal duty to notify the Licensing Authority of any change to their name or address. Failure to do so, without reasonable excuse, is an offence under Section 127(4) of the Licensing Act 2003. A person guilty of an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Level 2 on the standard scale.
