

**GARDEN WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE
(BROWN BINS)**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Council agrees to undertake the collection and disposal (where possible by composting) from supplied 240 litre wheeled bin/s from address specified.
2. The period of service paid for runs from the date the brown bin is delivered.
3. Bins must be left for collection at the normal bin collection point by 6.30 am on each collection day. The collection routes are planned within a tight schedule, collection times can vary considerably depending on the number of bins presented for collection throughout the year. Return visits cannot be made to properties. The time the collection crew visit a property is recorded if a bin is not out for collection.
4. The Council reserves the right not to remove waste, which is not as specified, dangerous or likely to damage the wheeled bin or the collection vehicle. It is the householders' responsibility to ensure that contents presented for collection conform to being only green garden waste that can easily be emptied from the bin. It must not be contained in any types of bags or sacks.
5. The bins supplied under this agreement are provided on a for-hire basis only and ownership remains with the Council at all times. The Bins shall be stored in a safe and responsible manner and must be suitably presented for ease of emptying on collection day. Additional loose waste will not be collected. Any loss or damage to the wheeled bins, however caused, excluding reasonable wear and tear, is the responsibility of the Hirer.
6. No waste other than that contained within the Brown Bin will be removed.
7. The Council reserves the right to revise collection schedules to accommodate public holidays and circumstances outside its direct control.

The Council must be informed if the Hirer moves from the address stated overleaf and the Hirer will inform the Council of his new address. (Bins may, at the discretion of the Council, be taken by the hirer to a new address within the Babergh District, but the Council must be informed so that future collections can be arranged).
