**Q2. What, if any, additional priorities would you like to see included in the Crime and Disorder Reduction Strategy 2002-2005?**

- Working in partnership addressing middle schools.
- There is a need to tackle underage drinking. Can we get MP to see if possession of alcohol under age is made an offence?
- The use of and parking of untaxed vehicles. Abandonment of cars/vehicles which leads to children playing with these abandoned vehicles.
- Close links with other D V Fora to ensure systems are established throughout Suffolk to provide co-ordinated good practice across the county.
- None.
- Burglary. Residential and other buildings.
- Extra police
- Protecting children from the effects of crime among youths and young adults.

- More intensive policing in rural areas to reduce burglary/theft from property. Reducing abandonment of motor vehicles.
- Reduction in sales of alcohol to U18s, addressing causes of youth crime. Reduction in fear of crime for elderly residents. Reduction in domestic burglary in rural areas.
- Reduction in fear of crime. If criminal damage is mainly caused by under 25 year olds, perhaps address youth disaffection.
- Whilst realising Sudbury and Hadleigh have the biggest problems, I would like to see the words "in Sudbury Town Centre" and "in Hadleigh" removed.
- With Pubwatch now being one of the most successful in the country, I fear that the police should work closer with the pubs example - follow ups any damage in the area drink/drug related outside of pub areas ban them from all public bars.
- Lack of inclusion of burglary needs explanation. Fear of crime needs to be included.
- More visible policing in villages. Better recording of domestic violence.
- Criminal damage to schools and anti-social behaviour at weekends, holidays and at night of property - endangers welfare and health and safety of pupils and staff. Arson has become a problem in school grounds.
- Regulation of fireworks which over the last week have been a nuisance. Skateboarding and cycling on paths.
- A drive against untaxed vehicles on highway. Police working more closely with Registered Social Landlords to reduce nuisance, harassment and criminal damage on estates.
- To reduce criminal damage throughout the region.
- More proactive approach by increasing number of community police patrols.
- Firmly establish a "hot line" telephone link with CCTV Centre in Ipswich for use by Taxi firms and local delivery service who could act as whistle blowers.
- To reduce domestic burglaries in rural areas of the district.
- None - with limited resources efforts should not be diluted.
- Road traffic offences - leading to "accident" reduction.
- I would suggest that substance misuse/crime should be concentrated on the dealers, with help being offered to users rather than a criminal record.
- Anti-social behaviour in Hadleigh particularly around any dwellings which contain very elderly and vulnerable people. This type of crime is very upsetting in particular to this group of people.
- Better lighting in certain areas ie. Hintlesham - the road leading into Hintlesham should have better road lighting, especially in the winter.
- Noise nuisance, street lighting, abandoned vehicles, Youth facilities - lack of (youths on corners and near shops)
- Anti-social behaviour relative to neighbours - input is needed - human behaviour in terms of difficulty/extreme deviancy when neighbours suffer as a consequence.
- Better street lighting. Noise pollution.
- All above should be more involved and open to all areas.
- Youth support - and fear of crime. Abandoned vehicles. Noise nuisance.
- Noise nuisance. Vehicle crime to include abandoned vehicles.
