Any challenge to this decision must be made on the grounds that the document has not been made in accordance with the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or alternatively, that a requirement of that Act or associated Regulations has not been complied with. Any such challenge must be made within three months after the date of this notice.
