SUMMER IN BABERGH: MORE CHOICE FOR MORE YOUNGSTERS!

Babergh District Council has come up with the perfect solution for residents fearing a summer of bored kids and frustrated parents - its expanded [Summer Activities Program for 2003](#)! This year sees the return of the ever-popular SPACE Camps PLUS the launch of two new additions: ACE Sports Camps and Village Tour 2003. The events will be happening in East Bergholt, Hadleigh, Gt. Cornard, Holbrook and a selection of villages throughout the district.

The SPACE camps will be running at Great Cornard (28th July to 1st August and again from 18th to 22nd August), Hadleigh (4th August to 8th August) and Holbrook (26th August to 29th August) and will cater for children aged 8 to 14. The camps consist of multi-sports activities, arts, crafts and dance. Each day lasts from 9am to 5pm and represents excellent value at £5.50 a day or £25 for a week.

The new ACE sports camps are being run in conjunction with East Bergholt Tennis Club and will give children the opportunity to learn and develop tennis skills, whilst enjoying a host of other games and sports. Duncan Prior, who is a highly qualified and experienced coach, will lead the tennis side of things. The camp is being held at East Bergholt High School Sports Centre on the 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th of August and cost £5.50 a day or £25 for the week.

Babergh has also organised a sports tour of 4 local villages. Throughout 1st and 2nd September, sports coaches will be visiting Polstead, Chelmondiston, Cockfield and Glemsford villages. They will be delivering fun and games to local children aged 6 to 12 for £2.50 a session.

Babergh's Sports Development Officer, Stuart Everett said, "Our summer holiday program offers children the chance to have a fun and action packed summer holiday! For the first time, we are expanding the services we offer to even more towns and villages in the district to give more children a greater opportunity to learn new skills and to have constructive fun."
