<b>Title of Document</b>	Draft Supplementary Planning Document on Affordable Housing – Regulation 17
<b>Subject Matter:</b>	The Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document which forms part of the Babergh Local Development Framework (SPD) provides detailed guidance in terms of the implementation of affordable housing Policies HS08 and HS09 of the Babergh Local Plan, Alteration No 2 within the district (The Supplementary Planning Document is one of a series of Local Development Documents that will form part of the Babergh Local Development Framework (LDF) when adopted. The LDF will eventually form the basis for decisions on spatial planning and land use within the administrative area of Babergh).
<b>Area Covered by Document:</b>	The Affordable Housing SPD relates to all of the administrative area of Babergh District Council.
<b>Consultation Period:</b>	Representations in support of or in objection to the SPD are invited during the statutory consultation period which runs from 17 December 2009 to 28 <sup>th</sup> of January 2009. Responses should be received by <b>5pm on the 28<sup>th</sup> of January 2009.</b>
