

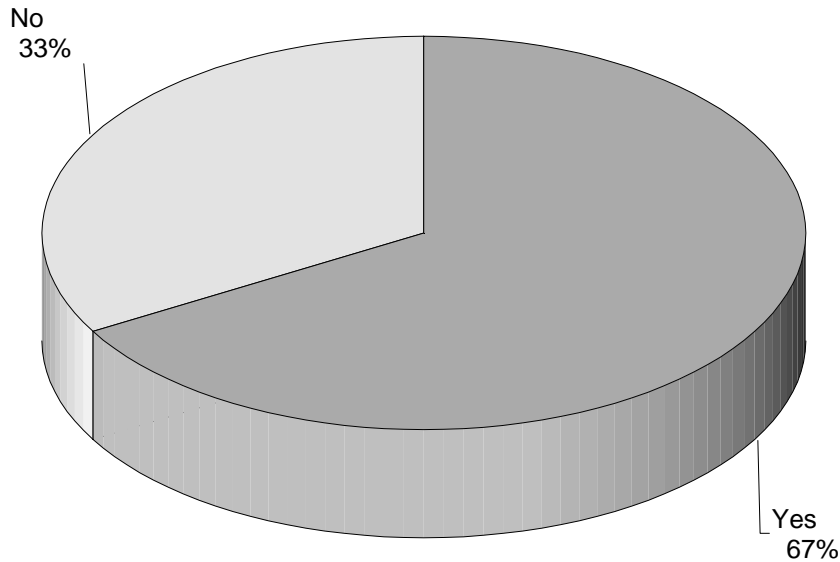

CAR PARKING SURVEY RELATING TO CAR AND COACH PARKING

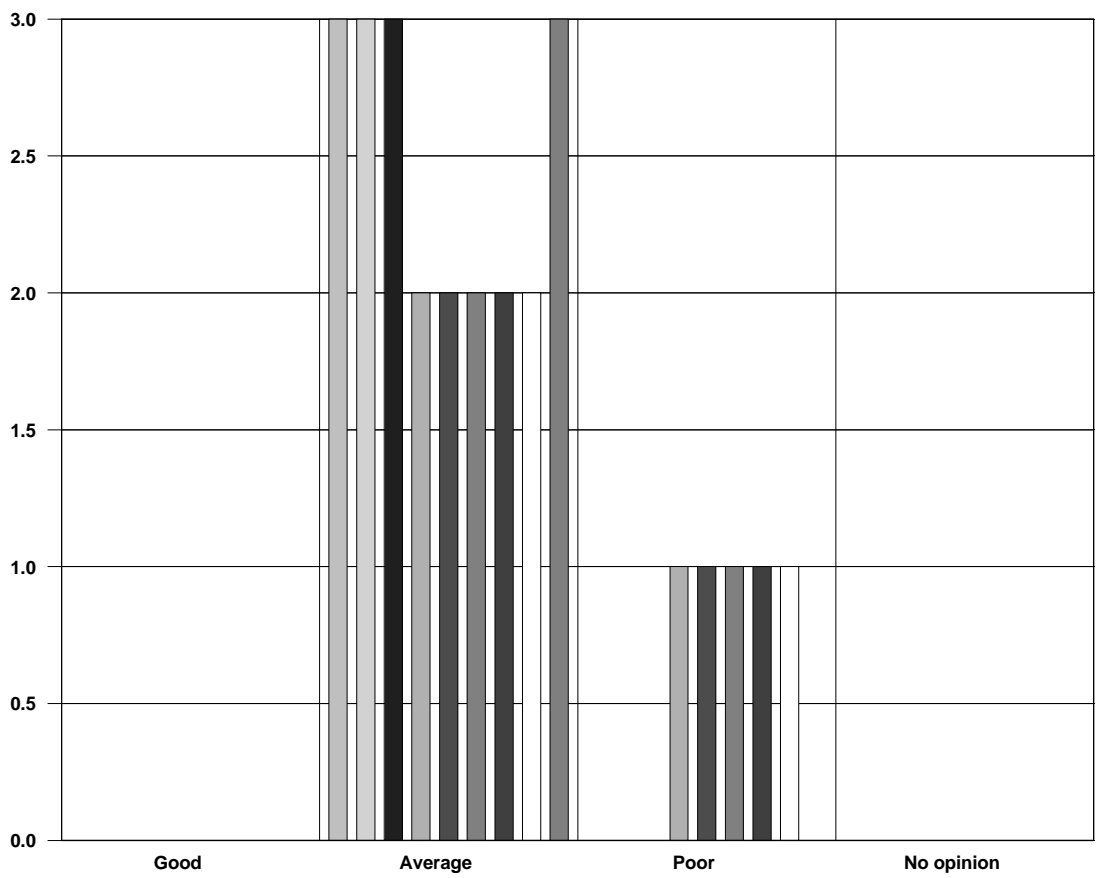
As at the end of 17 December 2001 we had received 3 responses relating to Car and Coach Parking.

Q1 Do you think there are enough coach parking spaces in the District generally?



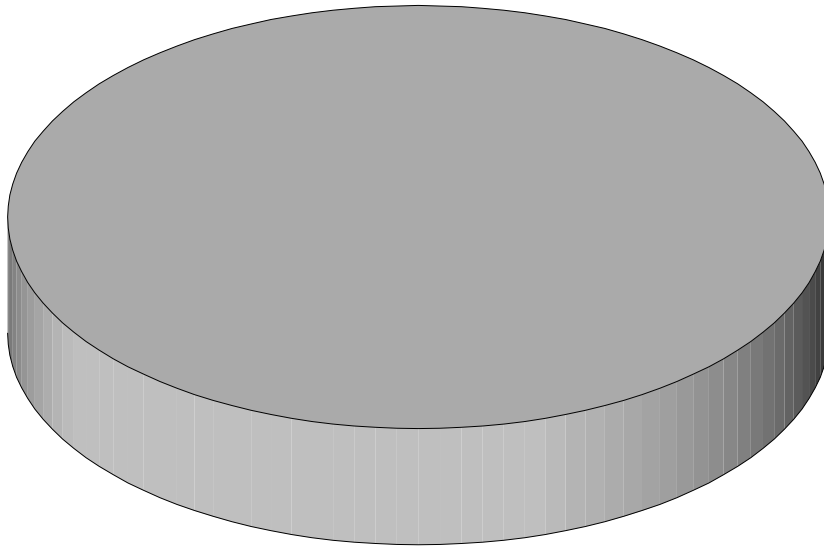
Q2. Please indicate how you rate the following in relation to the Council's car parks:

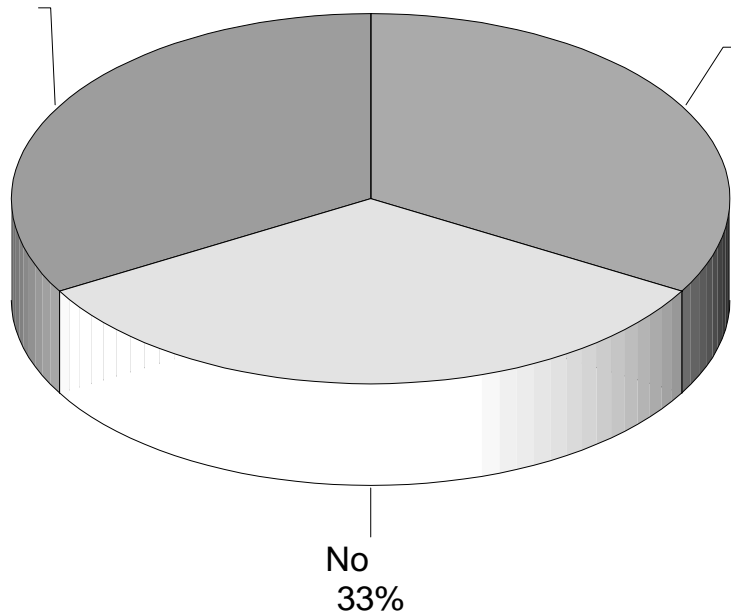
Q4. If yes, please indicate what information you feel would be helpful.

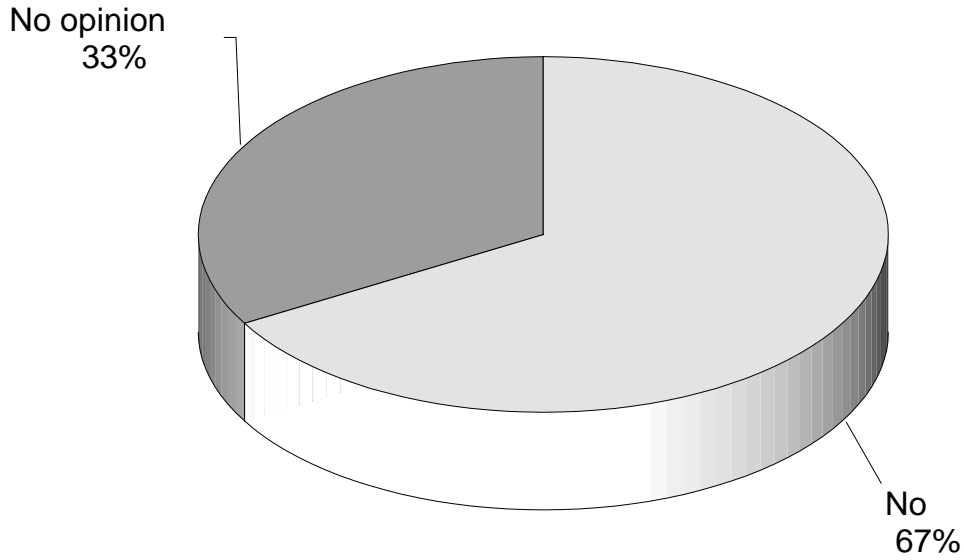
Q5. Would you like to see emergency contact points in our car parking areas?

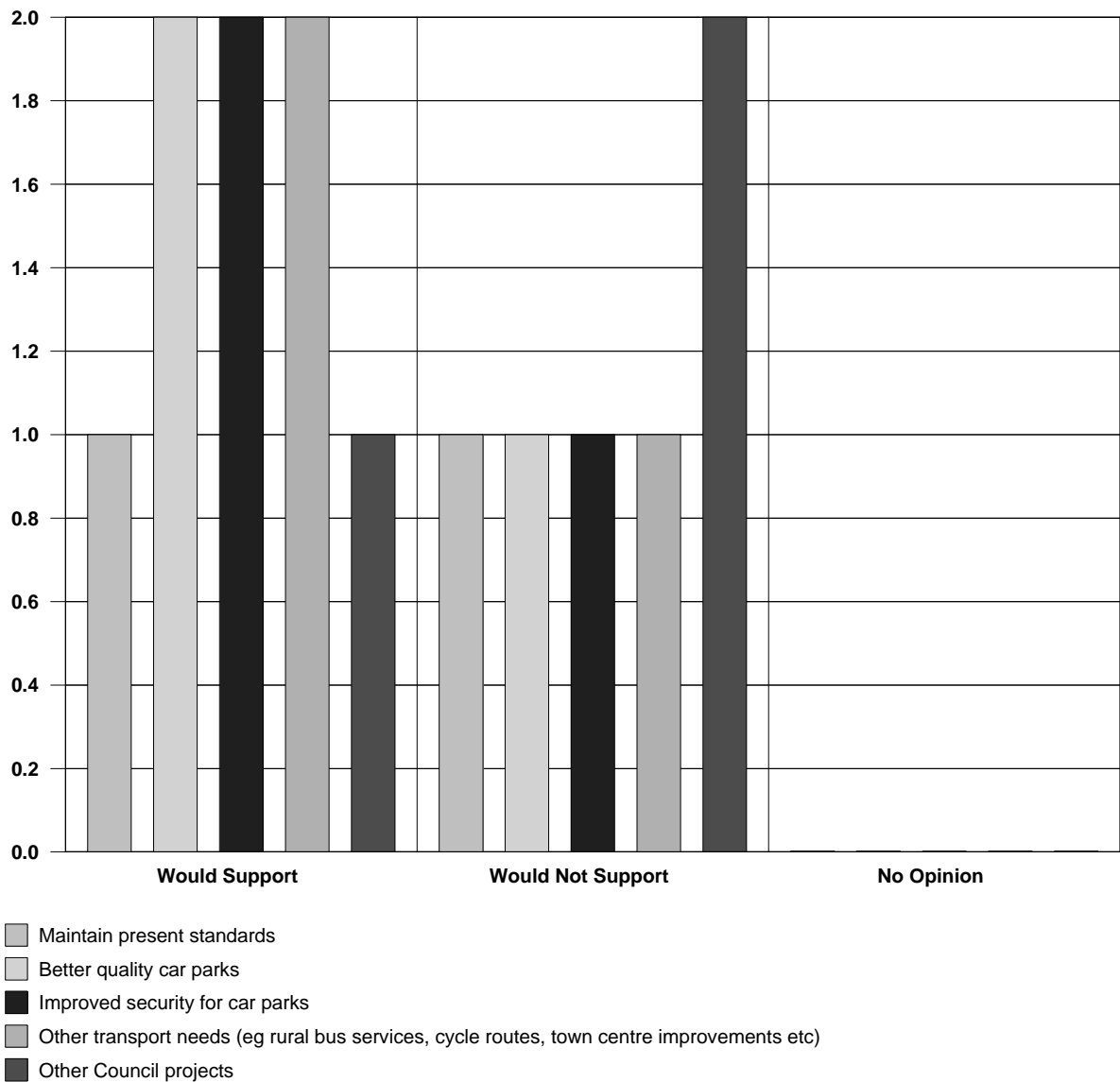

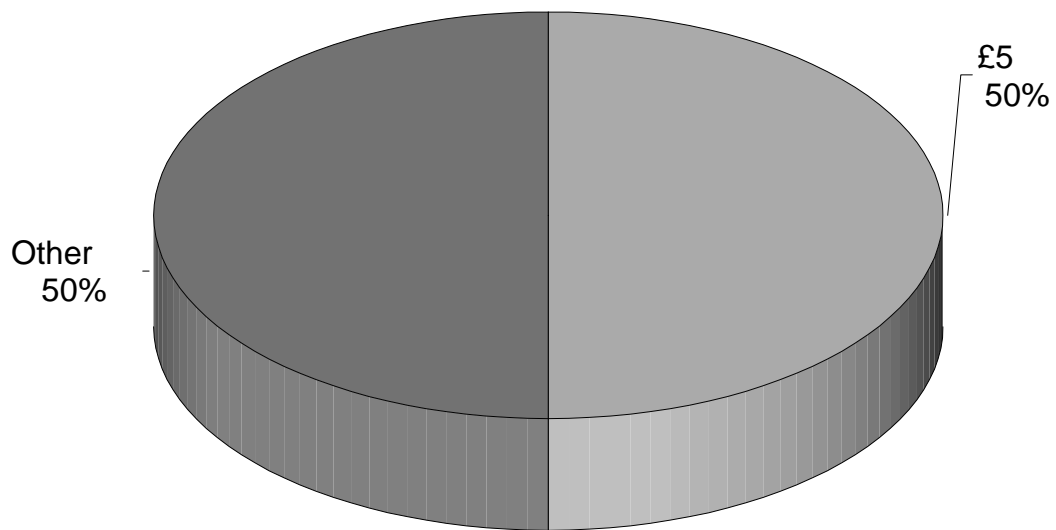
Q6. Is there enough provision for the disabled in our car parks?



Q7. Please indicate whether you would support the following issues through raising income from parking charges.



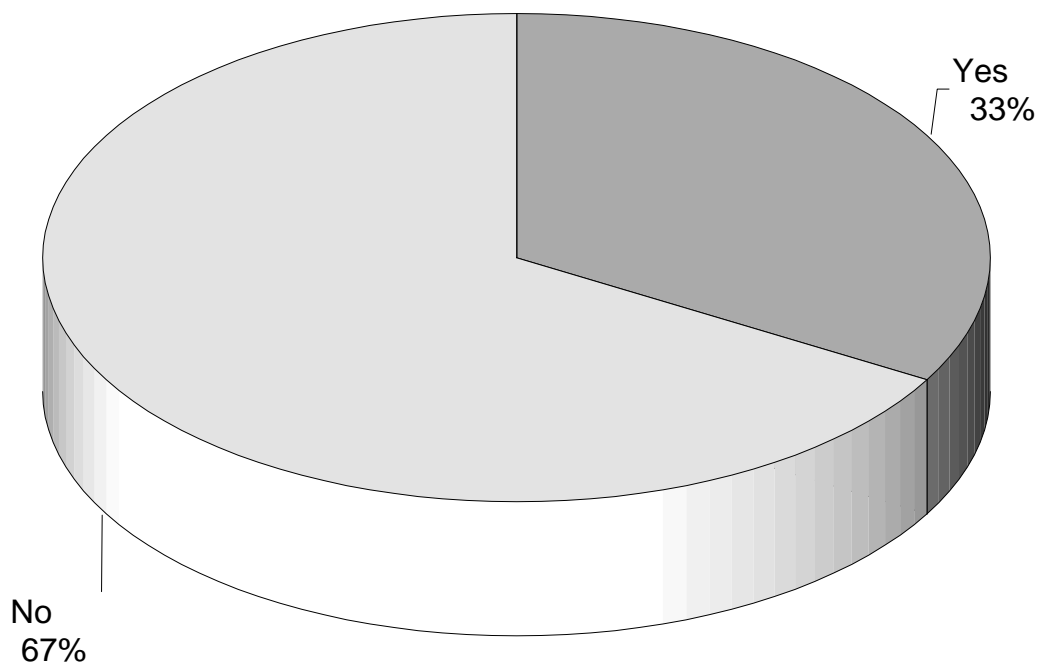
Q8. What would you consider to be a reasonable charge for long stay (over 4 hours) parking? (Per day)
