POLITICAL BALANCE AND COMPOSITION OF COMMITTEES

1. **SUMMARY**

Under the provisions of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989, a Local Authority is under a duty to review the allocation of seats to Political Groups at every annual meeting or as soon as practicable after that meeting. In addition, the composition of Committees must be approved at Annual Council each year.

2. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 2.1 That the Committees' size and numerical allocation of seats be approved as detailed in Appendix 1 to this report.
- 2.2 That the ungrouped member Mr C W Arthey be appointed to serve on the Development Committee.
- 2.3 That Committee seats be allocated as set out in Appendix 2 to this report.

3. **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS**

- 3.1 None

4. **KEY INFORMATION**

- 4.1 Under the provisions of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 where a local authority is grouped for local composition purposes, the Authority is required to make arrangements to ensure that its Committees share the same political balance as the full Council. (There is only one exception to this that applies in the case of the Standards Committee).
- 4.2 The Co-opted Members and Parish Council Representatives for the Standards Committee have been appointed for two years with effect from 1st March 2004.
- 4.3 The first step, therefore, is for the Council to approve the numerical allocation of Committee seats, and the calculation in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 is shown in Appendix 1 to this report. It will be noted from Appendix 1 that the precise figure to two decimal places is given in brackets. The calculation provides for 58 Committee seats to the various groups as follows:-

Liberal Democrat	- 24 seats
Independent	- 10 seats
Conservative	- 15 seats
Labour	- 8 seats
Others	- 1 seat
